

Online digital training description to the courses:



UN logistics / INTMOV P and NATO logistic

Aim

- (1) The aim of the three days online digital training is to give the participants an introduction to, and logistic knowledge level (understanding level) to all areas of the United logistics / the UNCOE system / the INTMOVP characteristics or NATO logistics (depended on what online digital training you attend).
- (2) The three days online digital training, together with the pre-study package is a standalone training that will give the participants a logistics knowledge level to solve specific logistic tasks in the framework of United Nations or NATO being able to use the knowledge to explain logistic concepts or structures.
- (3) For those that want/need more comprehensive logistic knowledge we recommend after the online digital training, apply for our six days Residential Practical and Functional-Oriented Training in Oslo/Norway.
- (a) This training is scenario-based, and case driven with focus on practical use of UN or NATO documents and procedures for implementing functional logistic solutions with recommendations.
- (b) This training (together with the online digital training) will give the participants a comprehensive logistic knowledge level (Applying level) being able to use the knowledge to plan and solve logistic tasks.

Performance / Learning objectives

- <u>UNCOE</u>: The aim of the three days online digital training is to give the participants an introduction to, and knowledge level (understanding level) to all areas of the United Nations Contingent Owned Equipment system included reimbursement procedures.
- <u>UNLOG:</u> The aim of the three days online digital training is to give the participants an introduction to, and logistic knowledge level (understanding level) to all areas of the United Nations logistics.
- <u>INTMOV P:</u> The aim of the three days online digital training is to give the participants an introduction to, and knowledge level (understanding level) to all areas of UN and NATO movement planning.
- <u>NATOLOG:</u> The aim of the three days online digital training is to give the participants an introduction to, and logistic knowledge level (understanding level) to all areas of the NATO logistics.

Target Audience

To be eligible to attend the online digital training, nominees must fulfil the criteria for the respective training in Oslo/Norway.

- Rank level: OF-2/OR-5 OF-4/OR-9 or equivalent police levels or UN personnel at P2-P4 levels or equivalent FS and GS levels. In certain circumstances, exceptions can be made.
- Required experience: Must have completed the NODEFIC UN or NATO pre-study package. (Participants at INTMOVP must do both UN and NATO pre-study).

Course duration

3 days online digital training. Conducted several times every year.

- Self-Study sessions: 4-5 lectures every day (up to 20min video lectures with sound) followed by questions/tasks to the participants.
- Joint online session (4 hours meeting) with focus on participant tasks, presentations and discussions based on the video presentations content.
- Video presentations, documents and tasks are available on Itslearning.
- After the online digital training, all participants are challenged to solve a mandatory assignment to ensure that the participant has achieved the required logistics knowledge level.
